According to our Business Performance in the first 6 months of 2023 of the Consolidated financial statements dated August 25th, 2023, the Company would like to clarify the changes as below:

Reasons:

In the first half of 2023, total revenue reached VND 8,556 billion, down 28% and profit after tax reached VND 162 billion, down 53% over the same period. This growth came entirely from the core business:

- **Laptops and tablets:** with the decline in consumer demand during difficult economic times, this segment achieved revenue of VND 2,436 billion, down 28% over the same period, reaching 44% of the year plan.
- **Mobile phones:** similar to the laptop segment, this segment is also affected by the current economic situation, revenue reached VND 4,089 billion, down 38% over the same period, reaching 47% of the year plan. .
- **Office equipment:** thanks to the revenue contribution of Achison company, the revenue of this segment only decreased slightly by 12% over the same period, reaching 1,410 billion VND in revenue, completing 37% of the year plan.
- **Home appliances:** revenue reached VND 331 billion, an impressive growth of 92% over the same period thanks to the addition of new brands and Whirlpool products, Xiaomi TVs are increasingly known and trusted by consumers. .
- **Consumer goods:** revenue of 290 billion dong, strong growth of 77% over the same period, mainly thanks to Digiworld entering the beverage industry and shaking hands with two giants, ABInbev and Lotte Chilsung.



Thus, in the first 6 months of 2023, the Company has completed 43% of the year plan in terms of revenue, and 41% of the year plan on profit after tax.
