Soc Trang Water Supply Joint Stock Company was established under Decision No. 1504/QD-UBND dated June 26, 2017 of the Soc Trang Provincial People's Committee, approving the plan and converting Soc Trang One Member Limited Liability Water Supply Company into a joint stock company. On December 28, 2017, the Company held its first General Meeting of Shareholders and officially operated under the joint stock company model according to Business Registration Certificate No. 2200107297 issued by the Soc Trang Department of Planning and Investment for the first time on December 23, 2009; 8th amendment on May 31, 2024, with a charter capital of 158.631.330.000 VND.

- Ensure the objective of not impacting the environment during project implementation and business production, such as: Conserving water resources, saving

water (surface water and groundwater), saving energy, using environmentally friendly machinery, equipment, and water treatment chemicals, etc.

- Ensure the successful implementation of social security tasks, meeting the needs of water use and ensuring the hygiene requirements of the community.

6. Risks

- The number of customers and the level of clean water usage after the operation of projects are often lower than committed before project implementation.
- The repair and renovation of infrastructure in the province has forced the company to incur costs for relocating pipelines, affecting water supply to customers and water loss control. In addition, the rate of water loss and revenue loss also causes significant damage to the company. The main causes include pipe bursts, using some water for flushing and cleaning water pipes, flushing wells, leaks at pipe network joints, etc. The process of finding, detecting, and fixing broken or leaking incidents also faces many difficulties when the water pipe system is located under existing constructions, causing time loss and cost increases. Losses include: some households registering to use water have misused it or not paid bills after use, used water without meters, etc.
- In addition, one of the significant risks is the increasingly serious climate change, posing a major risk to the business. Groundwater sources are gradually depleting, while surface water sources are also polluted. The climate change situation is becoming increasingly complex, including saltwater intrusion occurring earlier and becoming more severe in Soc Trang province. This affects the company's water supply, increasing production costs in treatment as well as searching for other water sources for replacement.

6. Report on the Company's environmental and social impacts

6.1. Raw material management

a. Total amount of raw materials used to produce main products and services

The Company uses raw materials and water treatment chemicals such as: Chlorine (70% Chlorine powder, 60% Chlorine granules, Chlorine tablets), PAC, filter sand, foam beads,... for the water treatment process to create a clean water source that meets the water usage needs of the people. These are common chemicals that do not require supporting substances, complex equipment and operations, but bring high efficiency in the water filtration process, stabilize the pH of the water, and contribute to creating a quality water source.

b. Percentage of recycled materials used to manufacture main products and services: None.

6.2. Energy Consumption

- a. Direct electricity consumption: 9.962.030 kW
- b. Electricity saved through the company's investment in installing a 20 kW solar power system at My Xuyen Water Supply Plant, a 38.3 kW system at Hai Ngu Water Station, and a 38,3 kW system at Thanh Tri Water Supply Plant. During the year, approximately 61.142 kW was used from the solar power system, replacing grid electricity from the Power Company.
 - c. Energy saving initiative reports: None.

6.3. Water Consumption

a. Water supply source and water usage

The company is currently managing and operating an urban water supply system including 23 plants and water treatment stations with a total permitted exploitation capacity of 91.530 m3/day and night, including 06 plants in Soc Trang city, 03 plants in 02 towns, and 14 plants in communes and townships.

With the core mission of providing clean water for industrial production and residents in the area, the company prioritizes investment in developing the water supply network alongside protecting water resources. The current water supply capacity into the network is about 73.300 m3/day and night, the main exploited water sources are groundwater (89%) and surface water (11%), the total number of operating wells is 64 (14 deep wells and 50 shallow wells) providing clean water to more than 101.843 customer households.

b. Percentage and total amount of recycled and reused water

The company is currently managing 23 water treatment plants and stations. Among them, 08 plants (Industrial Zone Plant, Phu Loi, My Xuyen 1, My Xuyen 2, My Xuyen 3, My Tu, Thanh Tri, Ke Sach) operate a closed-loop water treatment process after filtration, with no discharge into the environment. The total amount of reused water is about 1.419 m3/day, accounting for 49% of the total treated water of the entire company.

6.4. Compliance with water resource laws

- a. Number of times penalized for non-compliance with environmental laws and regulations: In 2024, the company implemented Decision No. 78/QĐ-XPHC, dated December 31, 2023, on administrative sanctions for exploiting and using water resources exceeding the permitted flow rate in the license at Ward 8 Water Plant.
- b. Total amount of fines for non-compliance with water resource and environmental laws and regulations: 2.321.289.883 VND

6.5. Labor-related policies

- a. Number of employees: 296 people, the average income for employees is 13.155.688 VND/person/month.
- b. Labor policies to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of employees: The company implements policies for employees according to regulations, resulting in 100% of employees having signed labor contracts, participating in health insurance, social insurance, unemployment insurance, and being paid on time and in full; occupational safety and health work is implemented according to regulations. During the year, the company organized periodic health checkups to detect diseases for employees at risk of occupational diseases at the Provincial General Hospital, with a total amount of 237.358.640 VND, and requested the issuance of health checkup monitoring books according to regulations.

c. Training activities:

In 2024, the Company did not conduct specialized training, primarily participating in seminars organized by the Southern Water Supply and Drainage Association and the State Securities Commission (SSC).

6.6. Report on responsibilities to the local community

The Company has effectively provided clean water to meet the needs of daily life and socio-economic development in urban areas within the province, ensuring quality and pricing according to regulations; invested in upgrading the water supply system to improve the quality of water supply products and services; invested in expanding the water supply network, expanding the coverage area, and increasing the number of households with access to clean water.

At the same time, in 2024, the Company also performed well in social charity contributions. The Company encouraged all employees to fully participate in social activities, gratitude, and mutual support such as contributing to the "For the Poor" fund, "Trade Union Shelter", "Disaster Prevention", "Supporting and sharing with compatriots during flood number 3",... and actively participated in emulation movements launched by the local government.

III. REPORT AND ASSESSMENT OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

1. Assessment of production and business performance

In the past year, extreme weather phenomena have occurred with increasing intensity and frequency in the province. The unpredictable climate change situation, prolonged heat, drought, and increasing saltwater intrusion have significantly affected the water supply. In Soc Trang city, the salinity of the water shows no signs of abating, affecting the exploited surface water sources, while groundwater wells are gradually becoming saline, groundwater levels are decreasing, the recovery of water sources is slow, and reserves are not sufficient for exploitation, leading to a shortage of water supply in some areas, affecting the production and business activities of the entire company.

The implementation of projects and the development of the water supply system have not met the set schedule. In parallel, the socio-economic situation in 2024 in general and the situation of businesses in 2024 in particular took place in a complex context with many difficulties, challenges, and advantages intertwined. Production and business costs, prices of raw materials, and input costs in production increased significantly. This also posed significant difficulties for the Company's business situation.

However, with the determination, unity, and efforts of the management and employees, the company's production and business results in 2024 continued to be maintained with a profit of 123.9% compared to the annual plan; employee regimes, policies, and salaries were also fully and promptly implemented according to regulations.

3. Improvements in organizational structure, policies, and management

In 2024, the company issued internal regulations: Governance Regulations, Regulations on the Operation of the Board of Directors, and Regulations on the Operation of the Supervisory Board (according to Resolution No. 02/2024/NQ-DHDCD dated August 16, 2024 of the General Meeting of Shareholders of Soc Trang Water Supply Joint Stock Company); Financial Regulations; Internal Spending Regulations; Welfare Fund Management Regulations; Reward Fund Management Regulations; and Information Disclosure Regulations (December 2024). The above information has been disclosed on the Company's website and the information disclosure system of the State Securities Commission, Hanoi Stock Exchange according to the information disclosure regulations of the law.

4. Future Development Plan

4.1. Business Production Solutions

Provincial Preventive Health Center to inspect and monitor water quality according to permitted standards.

- Remind subordinate units to regularly monitor business production indicators, reduce water loss, strengthen customer management, and assess the causes of production output increases and decreases at different times.

- Improve and enhance the level of production organization to increase labor productivity, save labor costs, materials, management costs, minimize unnecessary losses and damages during the production process, and save costs.

- Strengthen financial inspection, supervision, and management of the use of various types of expenses and product costs of the enterprise.

- Educate officials and employees to improve their sense of responsibility and promote emulation movements to successfully complete assigned tasks.
- Re-evaluate the work of each unit to establish labor quotas, rotate and arrange human resources to ensure effective leadership and production management.
- Develop a salary and bonus regime to motivate and encourage highly qualified officials and employees who are capable of undertaking and resolving important and complex tasks during implementation. Salaries must be linked to the results of performing assigned tasks.
- Regularly take care of the material and spiritual life of employees; effectively implement the grassroots democracy regime, create a good working environment, and encourage officials and employees to promote their abilities to complete assigned tasks well, contributing to the overall development of the company.

5. Explanation of the General Director Board regarding audit opinions:

Regarding the retrospective adjustment of errors according to the conclusion in Inspection Report No. 83/KL-TTr dated November 26, 2024 of Soc Trang Province in 2024 and the adjustment of errors related to corporate income tax expenses, this will lead to changes in some indicators on the Balance Sheet and the Statement of Business Performance, especially the indicator of Undistributed Profit After Tax of previous years, while as of December 31, 2024, the Company has paid 2022 dividends to shareholders amounting to 14.605.681.287 VND, and dividends determined to be payable for 2022 and 2023 amounting to 27.019.179.705 VND. Therefore, in order not to affect the dividend

payment plan for shareholders, the Company has adjusted the figures in the 2024 fiscal year.

Regarding the recognition of dividends payable to shareholders, the Company made adjustments and additions in early 2025.

1. Auditor's opinion

1.1. Basis for qualified opinion

The Company corrected errors according to the conclusions in Inspection Report No. 83/KL-TTr dated Novebemr 26, 2024 of Soc Trang Province Inspectorate in 2024 (see notes V.9, V.13, and V.17a in the Notes to the Financial Statements). If these errors were retrospectively adjusted according to the guidance of Vietnam Accounting Standard No. 29 - Changes in Accounting Policies, Accounting Estimates and Errors, the comparative figures on the Financial Statements for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2024 would change as follows:

In addition, the Company adjusted errors related to corporate income tax expenses of previous years with a total amount of 7.092.514.693 VND (see note V.13 in the Notes to the Financial Statements). If corporate income tax expenses were recorded retrospectively, on the Statement of Profit or Loss, "Current year corporate income tax expenses" (code 51) would decrease by 7.092.514.693 VND, resulting in a corresponding increase in current year profit after tax.

The Company announced dividend payments to shareholders according to Resolution No. 01/2024/NQ-DHDCD dated May 16, 2024 of the Extraordinary General Meeting of Shareholders 2024 and Resolution No. 02/2024/NQ-DHDCD dated August 16, 2024 of the Annual General Meeting of Shareholders 2024 with a total amount of 41.624.860.992 VND (see note V.17d in the Notes to the Financial Statements). As of December 31, 2024, the Company has paid dividends to shareholders of 14.605.681.287 VND, and the remaining dividends payable of 27.019.179.705 VND have not been recorded by the Company to reduce "Undistributed profit after tax" (code 421) and increase "Other short-term payables" (code 319).

1.2. Qualified Audit Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effects of the matters described in the "Basis for Qualified Opinion" paragraph, the Financial Statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Soc Trang Water Supply Joint Stock Company as of December 31, 2024, and its financial performance and its cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with Vietnamese Accounting Standards, the Vietnamese Accounting System for Enterprises, and relevant legal regulations on the preparation and presentation of Financial Statements.

The 2024 audited Financial Statements were prepared on March 05, 2025, posted on the company's website, and publicly disclosed as regulated.
