1. Cash and cash equivalents

Cash includes cash on hand and bank demand deposits.

Held-to-maturity investments

Net realizable value is the estimated selling price less the estimated costs of completing the products and the estimated costs needed for their consumption

Provision for decline in value of inventories is made for each kind of inventories when the net realizable value of that kind of inventories is less than cost

Intangible fixed assets

Intangible fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated amortization

The cost of intangible fixed assets comprises all the costs incurred by the Company to acquire those assets as of the time of putting such assets into the ready-for-use state

Intangible fixed assets are amortized on a straight-line basis over their estimated useful lives. The amortization period is in conformity with Circular No. 45/2013/TT-BTC dated 25/04/2013 by the Ministry of Finance. Details are as follows:

With regards to the investees who are required to prepare the consolidated financial statements, the provision is made based on the consolidated financial statements. For other cases, the provision is made based on the financial statements of the investees.

Prepaid expenses

prepayments are as follows: Prepaid expenses are reported as short-term or long-term prepaid expenses. These are expenditures that have been incurred but related to the operations of many accounting periods. The Company's primary
